As a Special Agent with the U.S. Secret Service, I am a subject matter expert on physical security. When assigned to protect the President, I designed security plans for global travel by identifying potential risks to high-profile and high-risk events. I have presented to Congress and the United Nations on threat assessments, as well as providing guidance to local stakeholders on threat mitigation. Prevention is the cornerstone of security, and to that end, I identify patterns utilizing open-source tools to pinpoint threats before they occur. Recently, I have been involved in investigating cyber-criminal intrusions into business networks.

Career Highlights

- Designed security plan during 2016 presidential campaign to mitigate risk by establishing secure demonstration areas & addressing intelligence regarding potential threat to candidate by setting up mock arrival point that allowed event to proceed without incident
- Mitigated attempted attack on the President by ordering open-source analysis of individual who had posted social media threat & positioning agents along his route to The White House
- Analyzed cyber-criminal intrusion into retail business network that identified hacking of Point-of-Sale software as portal for credit card theft
- Coordinated with targeted financial institution to investigate bank fraud & identity theft cases that impacted >800 victims by analyzing financial records, surveillance footage & open-source searches
- Advised Congressional Intelligence Subcommittee regarding threat assessments & preventative action items prior to Presidential Joint Session to Congress & United Nations
- Deployed to India to lead team ahead of presidential visit that required liaising with local law enforcement, providing status updates to D.C. headquarters, & assessing accuracy of intelligence from multiple sources
