As I rose through the ranks to become Deputy Inspector for the New York Police Department, I achieved success in carrying out investigations to mitigate internal and external risks. The common theme throughout my career has involved developing action plans in response to emergencies that threaten public safety. This involves building relationships with federal, state, and local government agencies, as well as community leaders. By thinking strategically, I formulate tactical plans that achieve measurable outcomes.

- As Incident Commander in aftermath of Hurricane Sandy, developed action plans to coordinate rescue & security operations with public safety agencies, National Guard, & utilities, directing deployment of >100 personnel & physical resources & working with community groups to coordinate restoration
- Coordinated relocation of hundreds of vehicles blocking streets following Hurricane Sandy flooding that re-opened streets to emergency crews
- Directed counterterrorism program before & during major events such as NYC Marathon to mitigate risk via coordinated response protocols with event planners
